Education Policy in 21st Century

Cambridge

Every other year, IFS holds a one-and-a-half day residential conference that brings together leading academics, policymakers and practitioners to share their perspectives on an important area of public policy. The 2009 conference will focus on education, addressing three key policy challenges:

- **Schools:** how can school quality and performance be improved? (Thursday afternoon)
- **Adult skills:** are effective interventions for low-skilled adults possible? (Friday morning)
- **Higher education:** where next for higher education policy? (Friday afternoon)
