

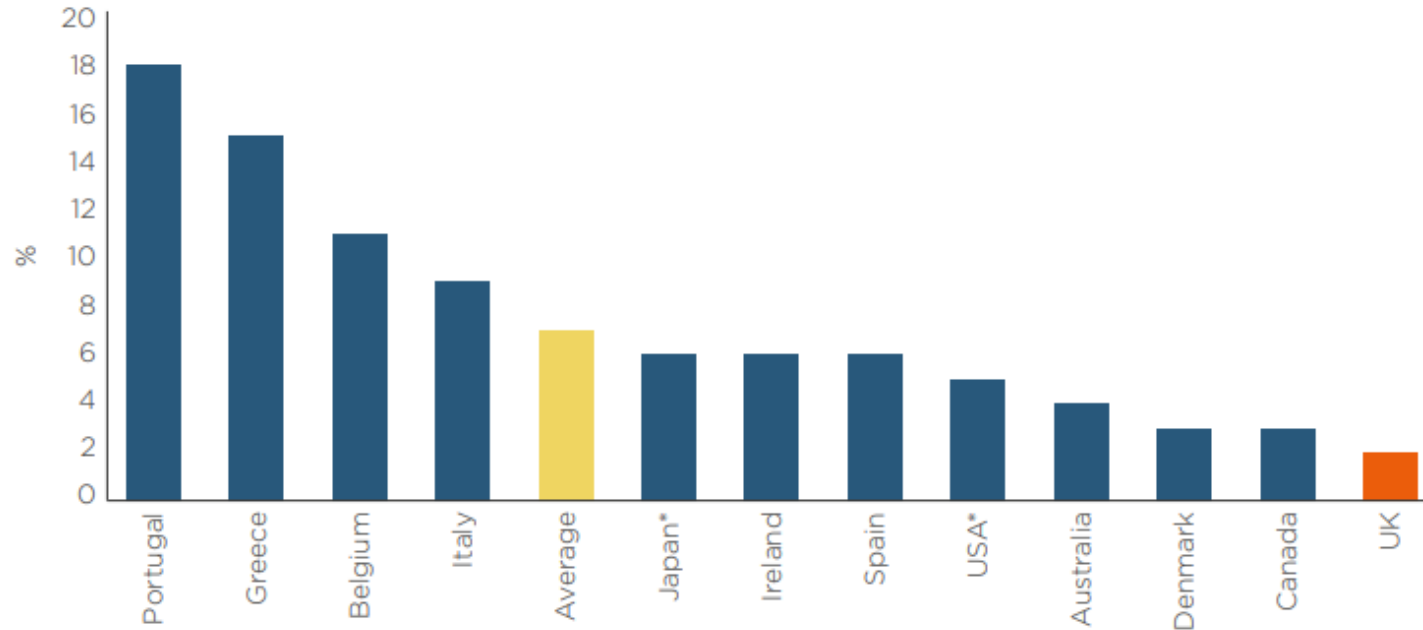

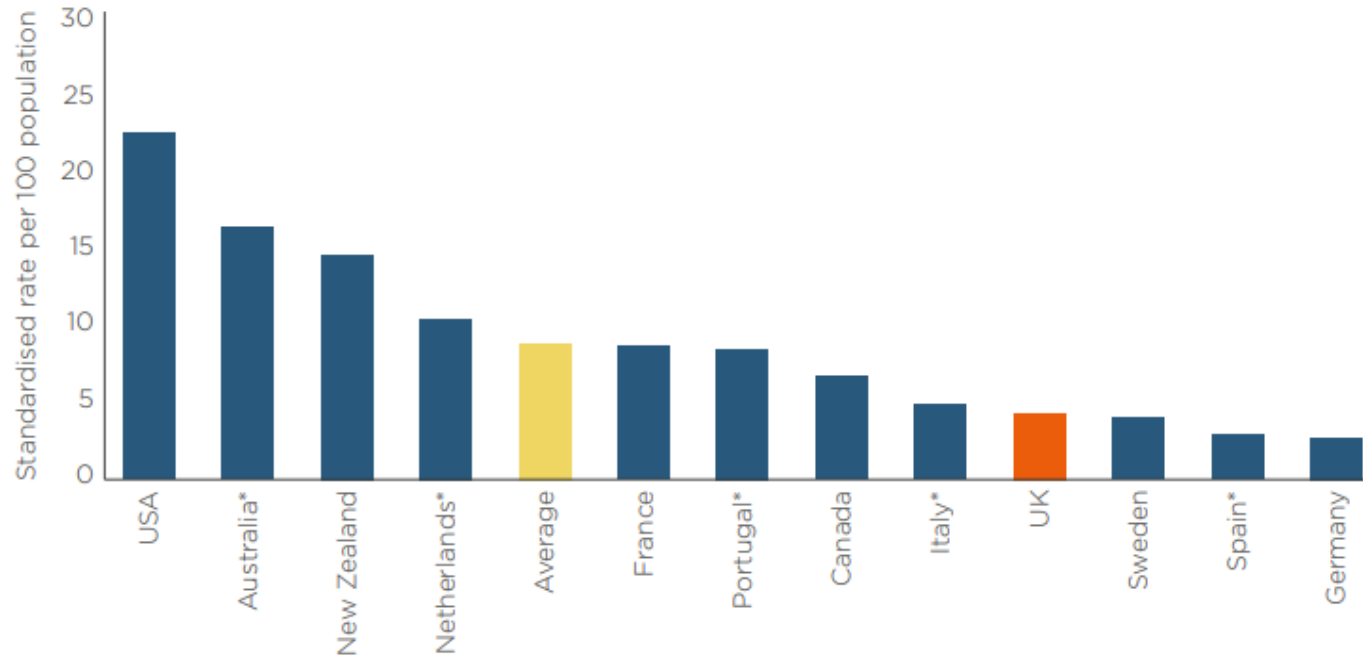
# Proportion of people spending more than 10% of income in out-of-pocket health care charges (2010)

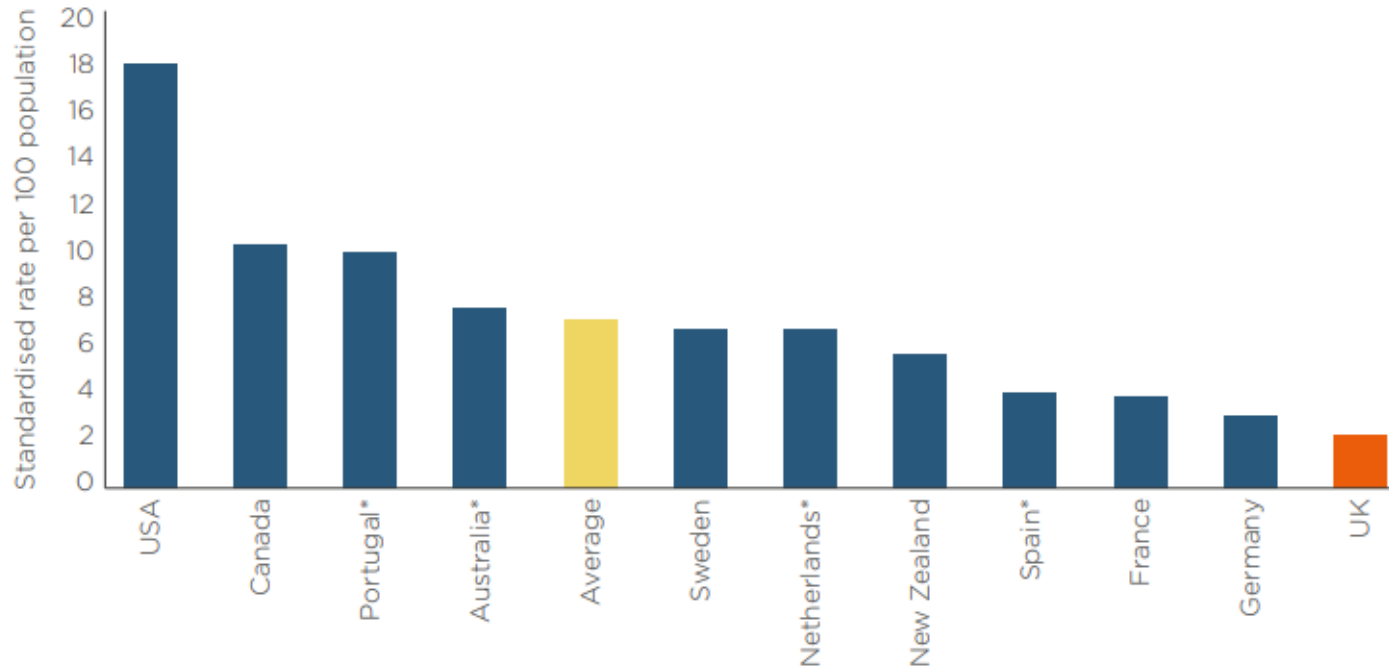
# Proportion of people who skipped a consultation due to cost (2016 or nearest year)

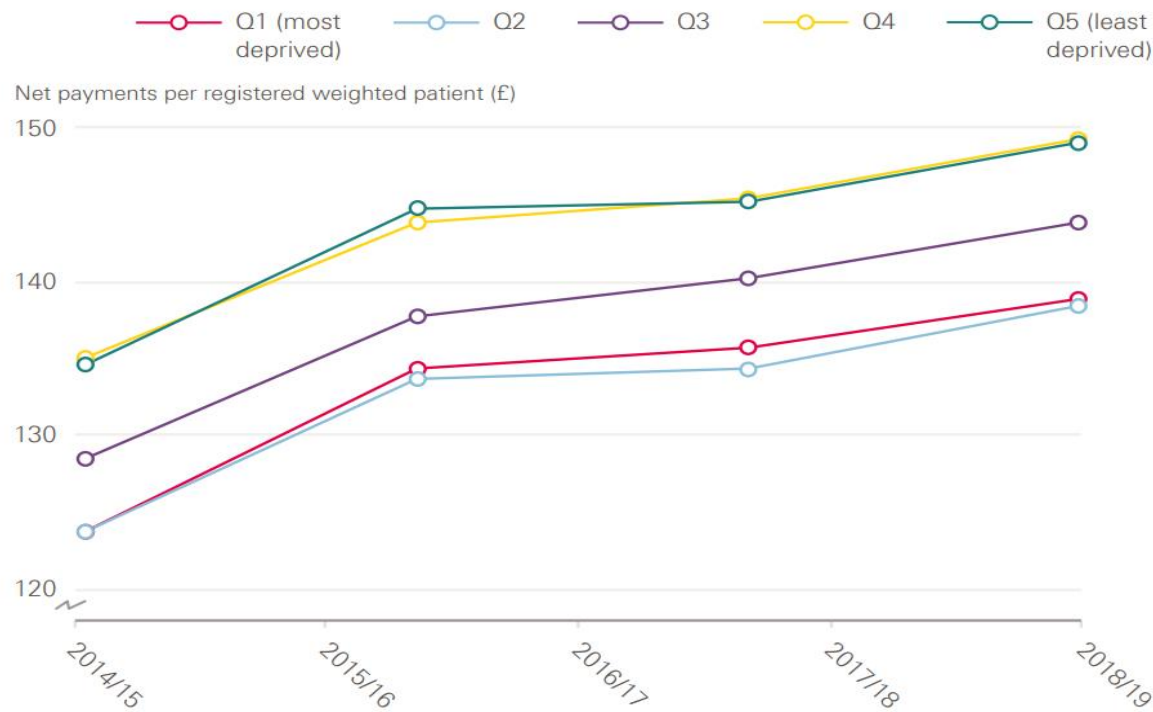
# Proportion of people who skipped a prescription medicine due to cost (2016 or nearest year)

# Trends in GP practice payments per patient by neighbourhood deprivation



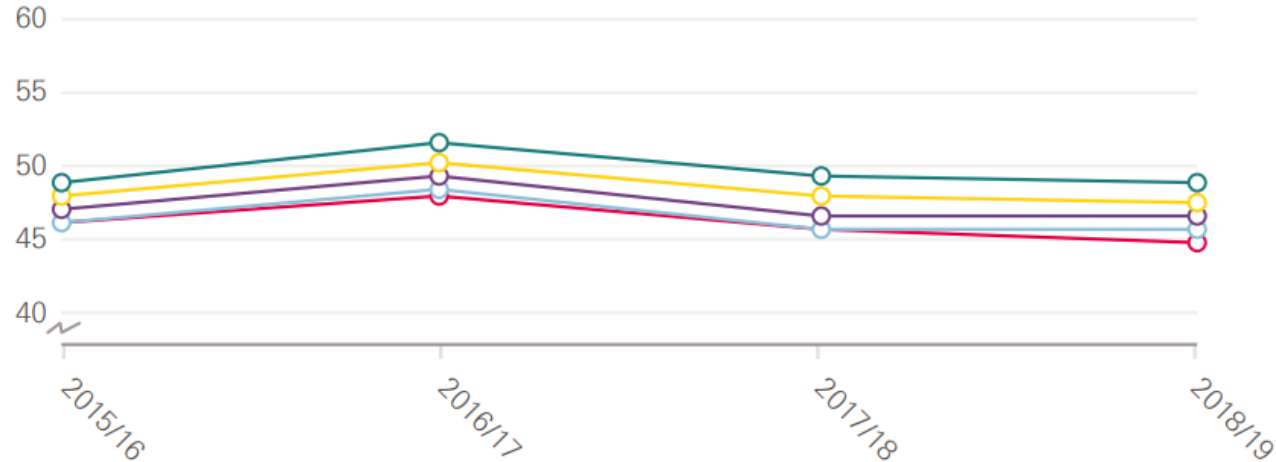

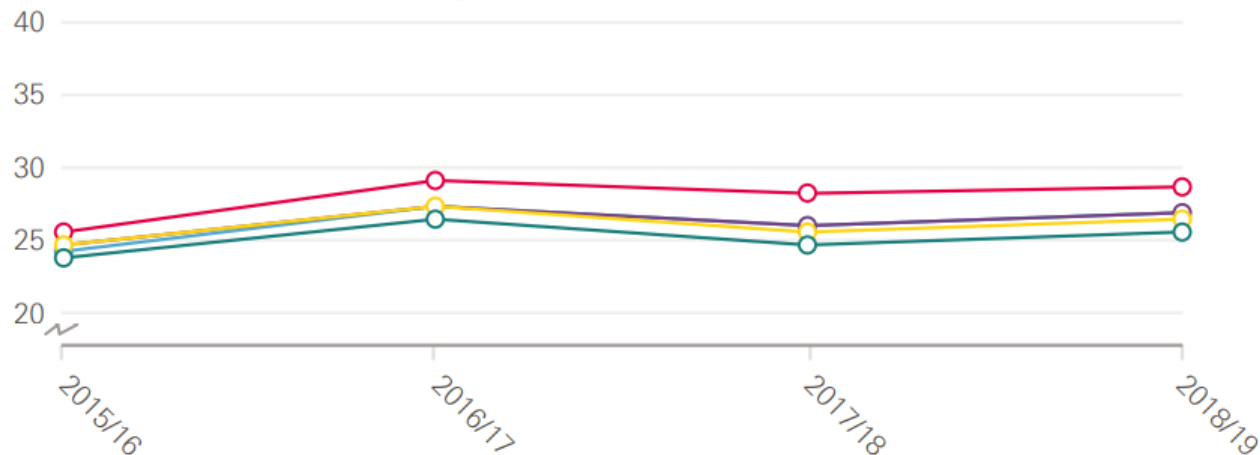
Numbers of staff (FTE) per 100,000 weighted population

Numbers of staff (FTE) per 100,000 weighted population



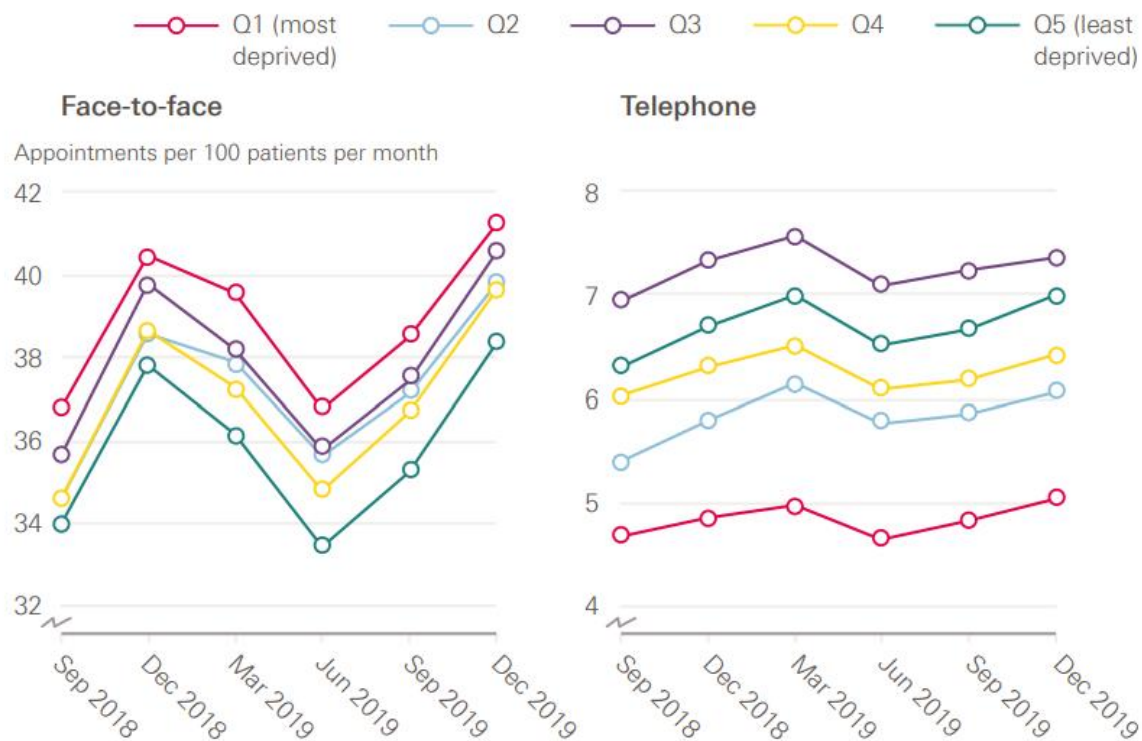
# Trends in primary care appointments carried out by GPs or other practice staff by neighbourhood deprivation

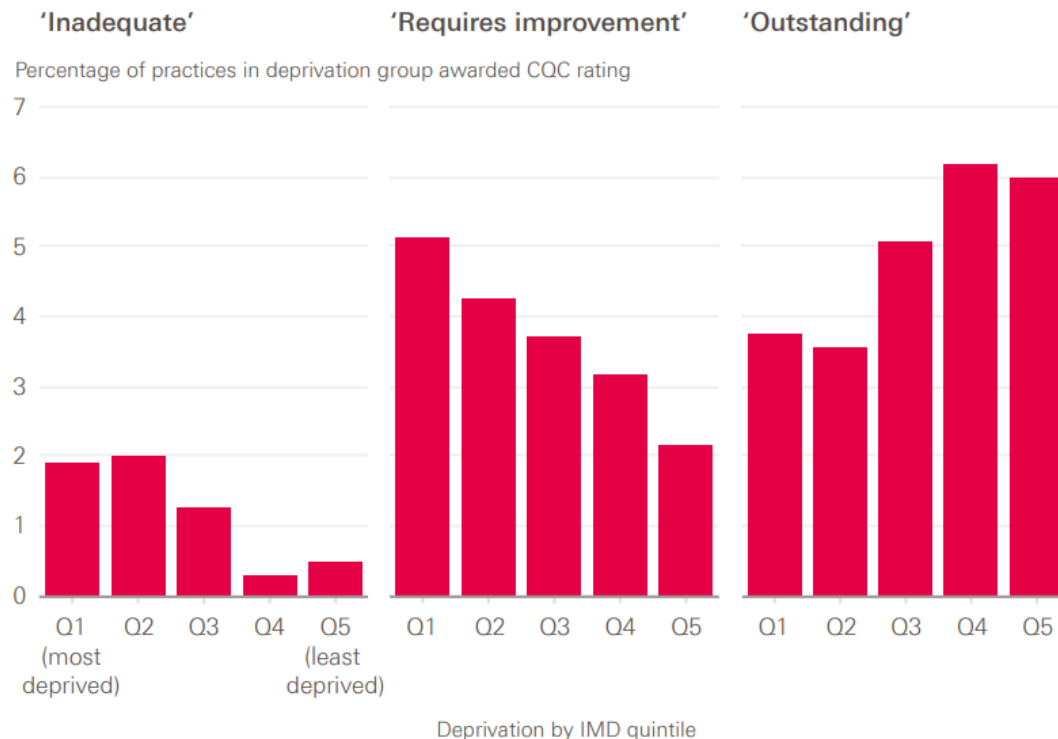
# Trends in face-to-face and telephone appointments by neighbourhood deprivation

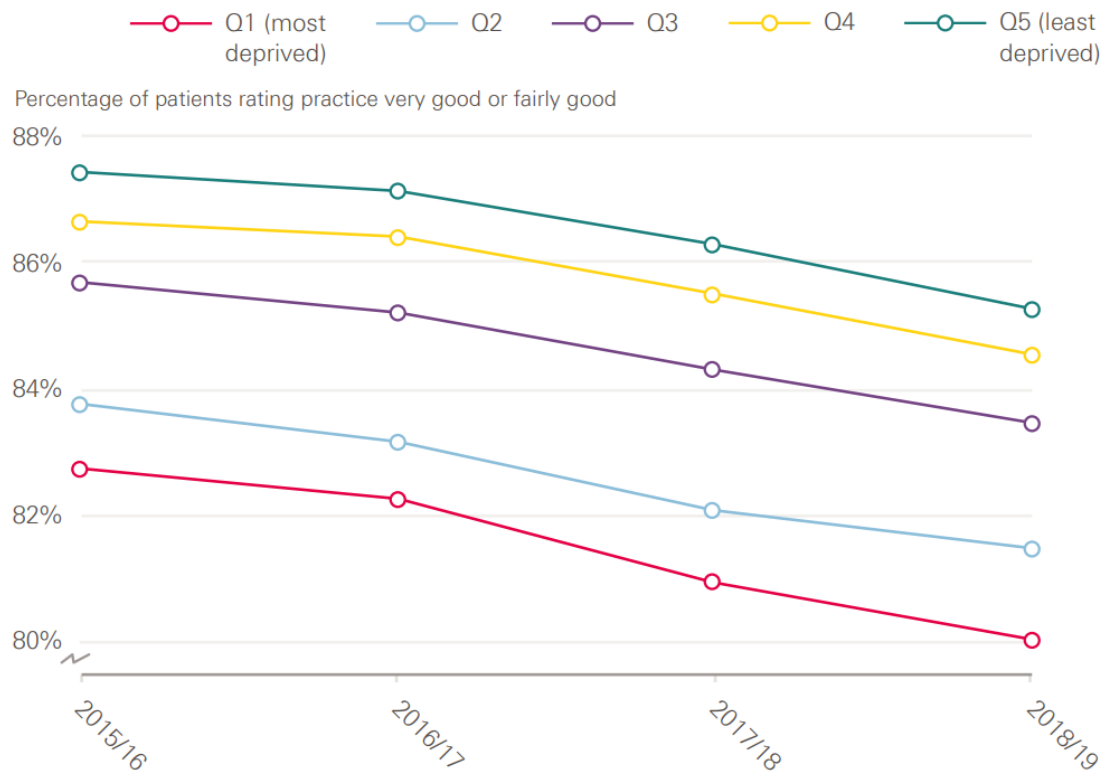
